

Age 1

- Making lots of consonant-vowel combinations (ba, mu, ti, whether nonsense or real word)
- Can use more than one vowel per word (even if nonsense word like 'babudi')
- Follows simple 1-step directions with cues
- Listens to simple stories
- 2-6 single words other than mama and dada

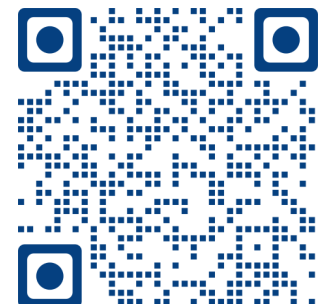
Age 2

- Starting to use sounds **b, p, n, m, d, h, w, t, k, g, f, ng, y**
- 50% of speech is understood
- Follows simple directions; knows up, down, in, on, under
- Starts putting two words together
- Pretends to read books

Age 3

- Uses the sounds **b, p, n, m, d, h, w, t, k, g, f, ng, y** accurately
- 75% of speech is understood
- Follows 2-step directions
- Uses 'I, we, you, he, she', starts using 'they, his, hers'
- Answers simple 'who, what, where, when' questions verbally

Quick Speech and Language Developmental Milestones

Ages 4-6

Age 4

- Uses the sounds **v, j, l, ch, s, sh, and z** accurately
- 75% of speech is understood
- Follows 2-step directions
- Makes sentences of 4 or more words, uses pronouns, plurals and 'is verb-ing' phrases

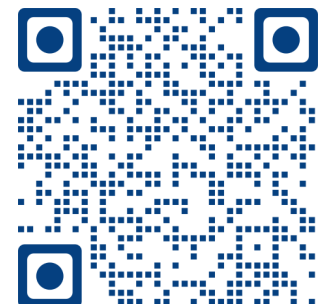
Age 5

- Uses the sounds **zh, r, th** accurately
- 90-100% of speech is understood
- Follows 3-step directions
- Makes grammatical sentences with 5 or more words
- Understands story sequence, knows many letter names
- Uses has/have and is/was accurately

Age 6

- Mastering all speech sounds, 100% of speech is understood
- Understands opposites, 'same/different', yesterday/tomorrow
- Asks questions for information, ask meanings of words
- Stays on topic or announces when shifting topic
